7th largest state

111k sq miles

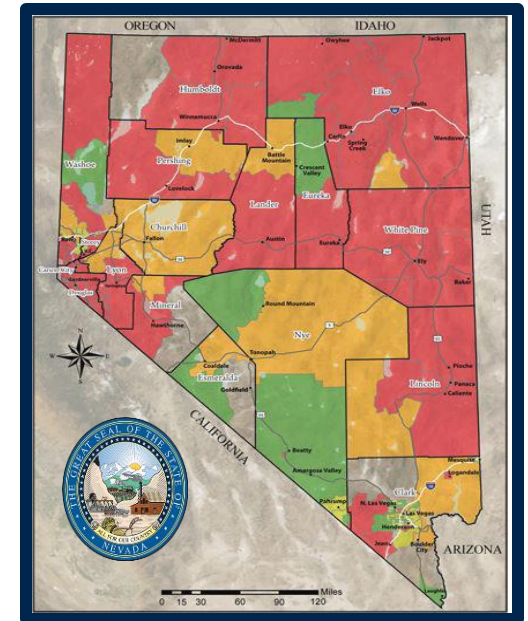
85% is BLM land

University Extension Office locations in each of Nevada's 17 counties as hubs for radon education and resources.

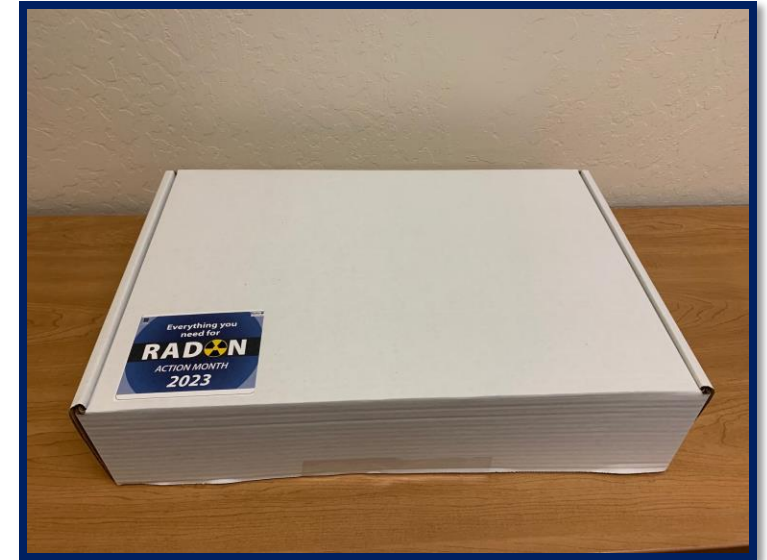
Trained staff at each location to provide information, guidance, and assistance regarding radon testing and mitigation.

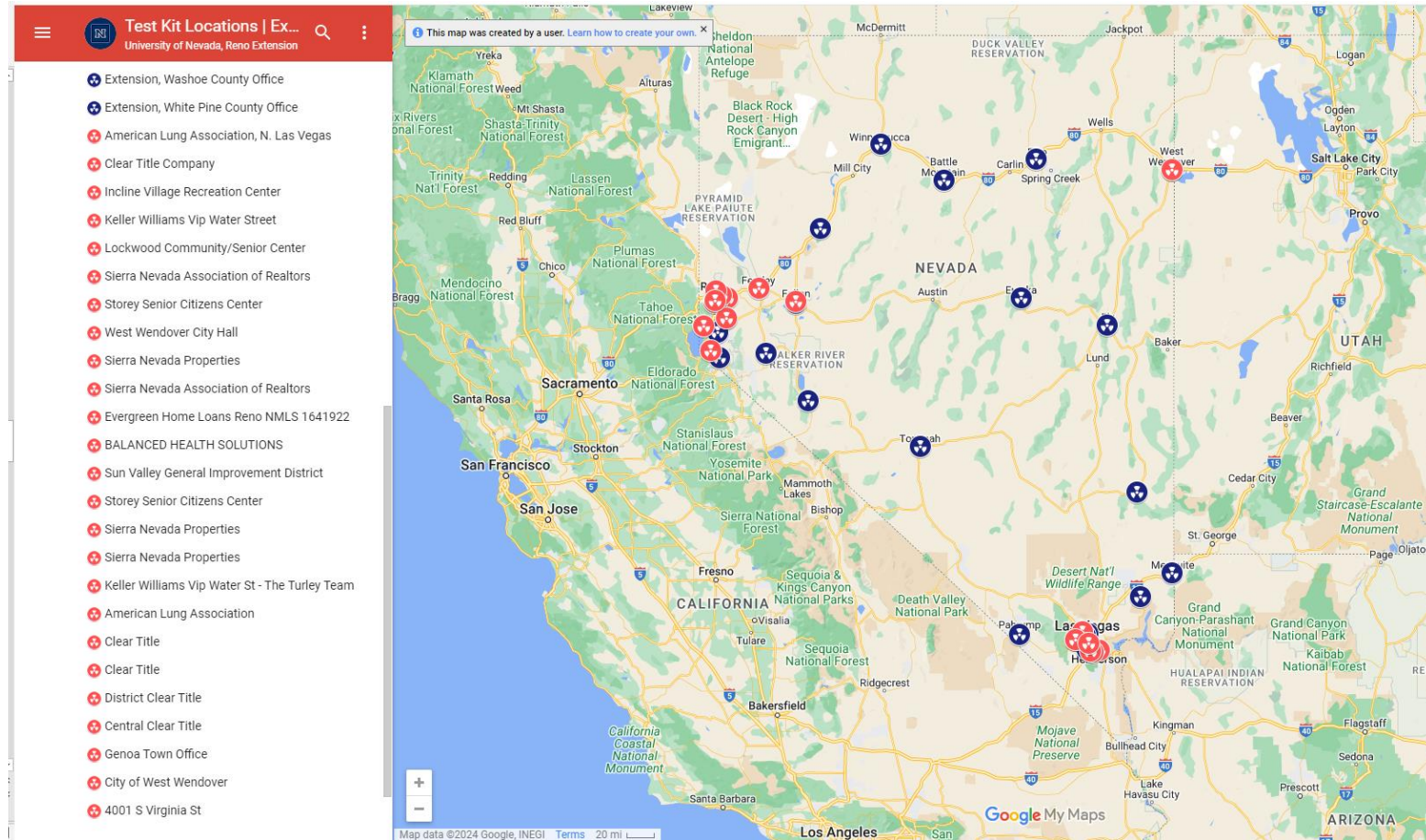
