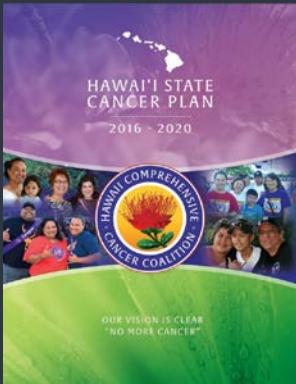

The Hawaii – Department of Health - Indoor and Radiological Health Branch conducts community health assessments for noise, radiation and indoor air pollution. It provides for access to essential services, and directs its resources towards problems that pose the greatest risk to public health and the environment. In addition, the branch operates the State Radiological Response Team under State Civil Defense.

Currently, Hawaii does not receive any SIRG funding.

Cancer Control Plan

Currently, Hawaii's Cancer Control Plan does not include radon.

Hawaii Pending/Enacted Legislation

Currently, there is no statutory authority to regulate indoor radon or the qualifications of those persons that perform radon measurement and mitigation services professionally in our state.
